Library Technician of the Year Award Criteria and Nomination Form

Library Technician of the Year Award: An award for outstanding work by a Library Technician in a Tasmanian school library will be recognised by the presentation of a certificate at the annual ASLA Tasmania in November/December each year.

Criteria for nomination:

1. The library technician must be a current financial/institutional member of ASLA Tas.
2. The library technician must have been working in Tasmanian education for the last 3 years.
3. The library technician has made an outstanding contribution to the role of the library at his/her school/s or office, raising the profile of the profession.
4. Nominations may be made by peers, supervisors, eg principals or members of the school library community in Tasmania.
