School Library Leader of the Year Award Criteria and Nomination Form

School Library Leader of the Year Award: An award in recognition of outstanding leadership or innovation to school librarianship in Tasmania. The teaching practice should be innovative in one school, or networking across schools, and show leadership in ICT integration, teaching for understanding, and learning by design. The award will be recognised by the presentation of a certificate at the annual ASLA Tasmania in November/December each year.

Criteria for nomination:

1. The teacher-librarian must be a current financial/institutional member of ASLA Tas.
2. The teacher-librarian must have working in Tasmanian education for the last 3 years.
3. The teacher-librarian must have made an outstanding contribution to school library leadership, raising the profile of the profession.
4. Nominations may be made by peers, supervisors, eg principals or members of the school library community in Tasmania.
