School Library Research Fellow of the Year Award Criteria and Nomination Form

School Library Research Fellow of the Year Award: A grant that may be provided to provide practical support to a teacher-librarian or library technician to implement an evidence based research project on information literacy outcomes and the impact of school libraries on student achievement.

Criteria for Nomination:

1. The teacher-librarian or library technician must be a current financial/institutional member of ASLA Tas.
2. The teacher-librarian or library technician must have working in Tasmanian education for the last 3 years.
3. The teacher-librarian or library technician may use the grant to support a research project currently underway or planned to commence during the year.
4. The research project will contribute to the body of evidence on the impact of school libraries on student achievement in Australian education.
5. Nominations may be made by peers, supervisors, eg principals or members of the school library community in Tasmania.
