Doreen Hopkins Medal Criteria and Nomination Form

Doreen Hopkins Medal: A prestigious award for distinguished service to school librarianship in Tasmania, awarded annually at the first meeting for the new school year.

Doreen Hopkins has had a long and distinguished service to secondary school libraries in Tasmania from Ulverstone High School to New Town High School. During the 70s-90s, Doreen represented the professionalism of dedicated teacher-librarians in Tasmania, in periods of change and innovation with teaching and learning through literature, whole school resource management, and installation of computerised library management systems. Throughout her career, Doreen has been a very special friend and mentor to many teacher librarians still working in Tasmanian schools today

Criteria for nomination:

1. The teacher-librarian must be a current financial/institutional member of ASLA Tas.
2. The teacher-librarian must have been working in Tasmanian education for the last 10 years.
3. The teacher-librarian has made an outstanding contribution to teaching and learning at his/her school/s and has raised the profile of the profession.
4. Nominations may be made by peers, supervisors, eg principals or members of the school library community in Tasmania.
