Some venues will have strict number limits

- **Reconciliation Walk**

Reconciliation Place Tour - provides an opportunity to represent shared history from the perspective of the original owners and those who came later. Wander down pathways among public artworks and explore the themes of Indigenous achievements, partnerships, belonging and connection to the land and water

MEETING PLACE: Steps of the National Library (within walking distance)

- **Australian War Memorial**

Australian War Memorial - provides an opportunity to examine the wide range of resources that are available for teachers to use with their students through inquiry and discovery at the Australian War Memorial

MEETING PLACE: Australian War Memorial, Treloar Cres, Campbell, ACT

- **Film and Sound Museum**

Film and Sound Archive Workshop – A guided workshop on using the NFS archives as a 'research tool' for teachers to use with their students

MEETING PLACE: Film and Sound Museum, McCoy Circuit, Acton, ACT (in the grounds of ANU)

- **National Centre for Children's Literature**

National Centre of Children's Literature - A guided tour of the archives of children's literature, including first editions and original artwork from children's books. An opportunity to examine how this wonderful resource can be used in your school library to enrich your students reading experiences.

- National Gallery

National Gallery Convergences between art and literature at the NGA Experience Love & Desire: Pre-Raphaelite Masterpieces from the Tate with a tour that explores how this group of rebellious young artists of the mid-19th century in Britain were inspired by the great love stories of history and literature. Also gain an insight into the NGA's Research Library, home to the most comprehensive collection of visual arts literature in Australia and documents the history and development of our nation's art and culture.

MEETING PLACE: National Gallery of Australia, Parkes Place East, Parkes, ACT

- Botanical Gardens

Botanical Gardens - A 'Teacher Teaser' guided walk around the gardens which promises to be fun as well as providing an insight into programs on offer for students, including a visit to the Botanical Bookshop

MEETING PLACE: Botanical Gardens, Clunies Ross St., Acton, ACT

- Questacon

Questacon - a 2 hour practical workshop that will hone in on the thinking processes that underpin digital technologies. These processes are then used to drive the development of a school's Makerspace and processes to ensure a Makerspace's sustainability.
